Bringing down the house on Tuesday, April 19 will be **Butch Bradley**, one of the most popular stand-up comedians on today's comedy circuit. Bradley is a veteran of the Laugh Factory, Improv and The Comedy Store and has opened for top comedians Ray Romano, Lewis Black and Cathy Ladman. He has also appeared on numerous television shows including THE MARTIN SHORT SHOW, VH1's THE LIST, THE JAMIE KENNEDY EXPERIMENT and more. He also headed to Afghanistan and Iraq, supporting our troops on the USO Tour. Opening for Bradley will be **David Gee**, a talented comedian who is also a comic writer and voice-over artist.
