Since 1990, Los Angeles based Scot Bruce has been entertaining audiences with his uncanny resemblance to the young “King” and his ability to sing, strum a guitar, and swivel his hips. His live show has taken him across the United States and all over the world performing such unforgettable ELVIS hits like “Blue Suede Shoes”, “Heatbreak Hotel”, “I Need Your Love Tonight”, and more.

It all started while pursuing a music and acting career (and having been a musician and big Elvis fan all of his life), Scot started performing a 1950’s era Elvis show as a way to survive the lean times and this blossomed into a full time career. He has appeared in music videos with Faith Hill and Sheryl Crow, had recurring roles on the hit soap operas *Days of Our Lives* and *The Bold and The Beautiful*. Scot has appeared in commercials for Pizza Hut and the California Lottery “Elvis” ad campaign and in several successful productions of *Idols of the King*. He also performs regularly at Disneyland and tours with the “Legends of Rock & Roll - Buddy, Roy & Elvis.”
